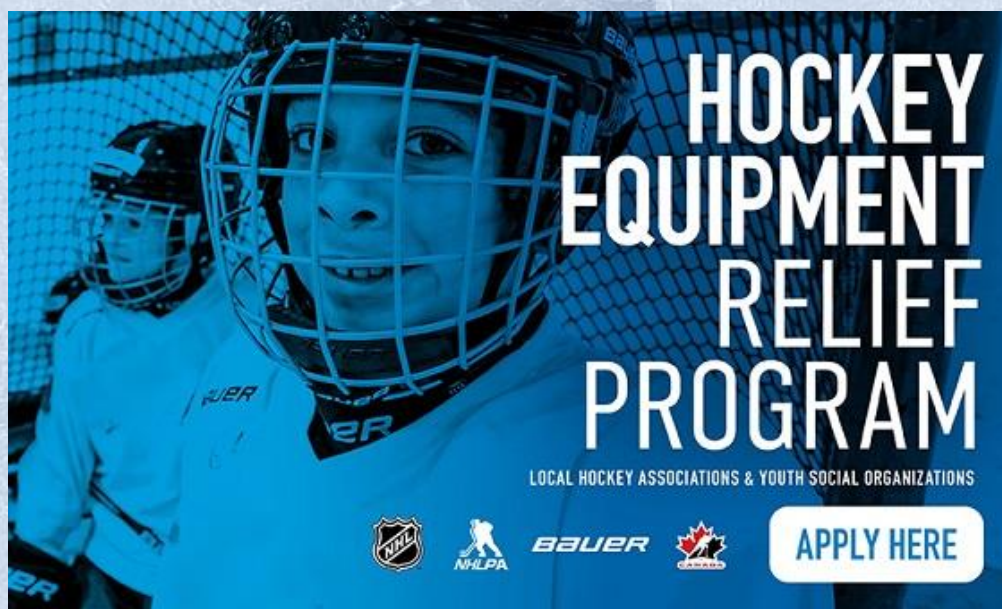


GOULDS AND SOUTHERN SHORE MINOR HOCKEY ASSOCIATIONS



THE NATIONAL HOCKEY LEAGUE (NHL®), THE NATIONAL HOCKEY LEAGUE PLAYERS' ASSOCIATION (NHLPA), BAUER HOCKEY AND HOCKEY CANADA HAVE LAUNCHED THE HOCKEY EQUIPMENT RELIEF PROGRAM. AS COMMUNITIES BEGIN TO RE-OPEN AND KIDS LOOK TO RE-ENGAGE IN SPORTS, THIS PROGRAM WILL HELP FAMILIES FINANCIALLY IMPACTED BY COVID-19 GET THEIR KIDS BACK ON THE ICE.

Eligibility

If COVID-19 has had a financial or health impact on your family, your child may be eligible to receive a donation of hockey equipment through GMHA & SSMHA.

You must be registered or planning to register with either GMHA or SSMHA.

The equipment being donated will fit children between the approximate ages of 4 to 12 years old. There will be entry-level Bauer skates, sticks, helmets, and gloves available in various youth and junior sizes. The equipment provided pays particular attention to popular sizes, however supply is limited so there is no guarantee the proper size will be available. The equipment also may not be distributed as a full set. A child may receive between 1-4 pieces from the set depending on their needs and what is available. If your family is eligible, more than one child in your family may receive equipment as needed. Supply is limited so depending on demand, eligibility may be determined by the level of need.
